PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION

Unit B₁: 0-292 cm
 Dark grey, horizontally laminated mud.
 Lamination defined by variation in color of sediment, and occasionally, slight variation of grain size and porosity. No apparent shells in core. Top of unit (above 30 cm) is burrowed. Heavy burrowing above 10 cm. Contact with B₂ is gradual.

B₂: 292-483 cm
 Dark grey mud with occasional med-dark grey, fine to very fine sands. Bedding varies between laminated and lenticular. Sand at base (483-462 cm) is planar-bedded sand. Becomes wavy-bedded (462-446 cm). Lenticular to laminated above 446 cm. Little burrowing through most of unit, except at 385-355 cm.
