PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION

0-287cm - Massive to horizontally laminated dark gray muds, fine grained in section. Higher sand content alternating w/ mud layers and silt/sands from 180-287cm. Some section shows some deformation. No organics, shells or bioturbation.

287-440cm - Tan fine grained horizontally laminated sand w/ some silt content from 280-350cm. From 350-440cm pretty good looking sands, minor silt contents. No shells, organics or deformation.
