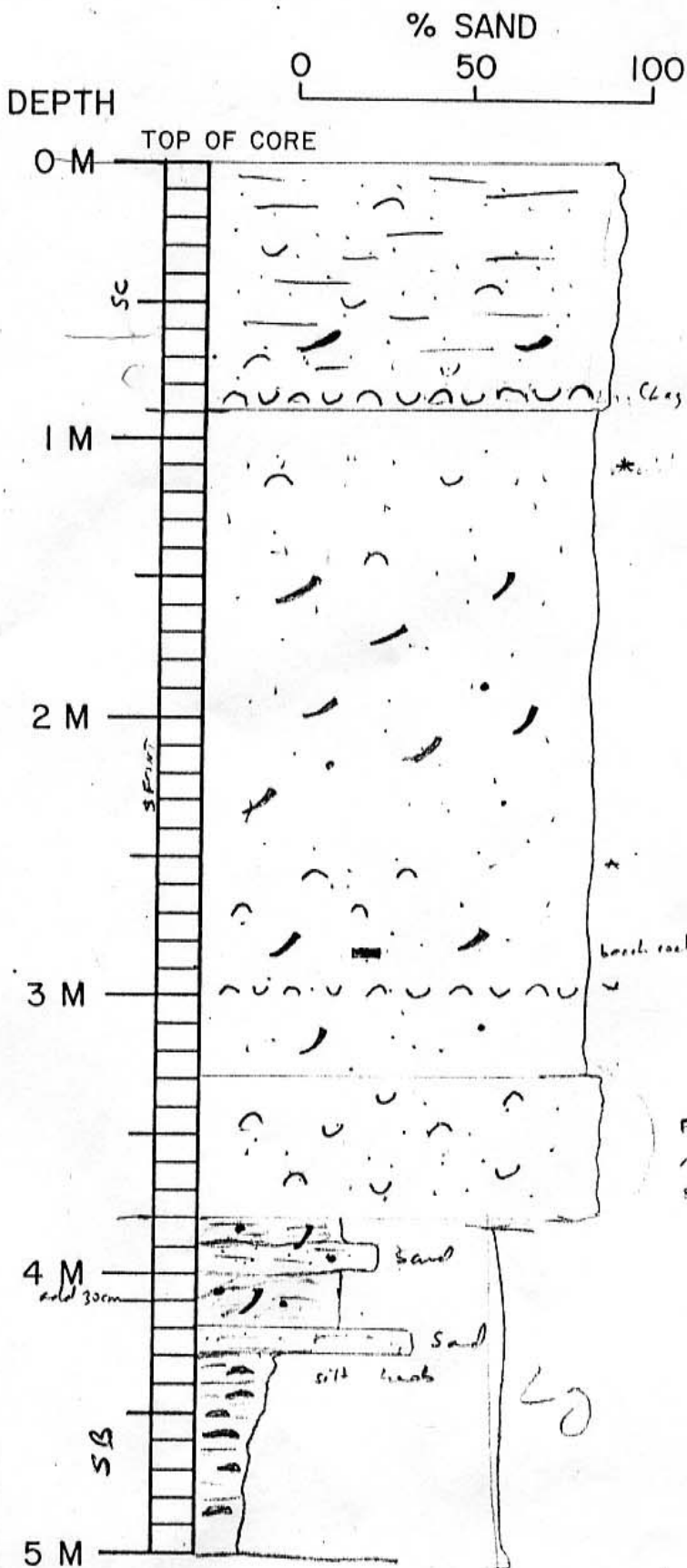

Shoal Crest

Fine-grain, well sorted quartzose sand and shell, *Mulina*, *Ostracoda*, *rangia* present - bracketed caline - *Marina* shells + beach rock, Parallel laminations faintly visible; burrows near base horizontal - clay filled; Lag at base - shells - sharp contact

Central Shoal

Fine-grained, well sorted quartzose sand with some shell, massive fine appearance; burrowing increases down; horizontal, circular and horizontal burrows - clay filled; shells are oriented in plane; a lot of burrowing between - 1.8 - 3.3, horizontal > 10% massive - *Ostracoda*, *rangia*, beach rock (- 2.85)

Shoal Base

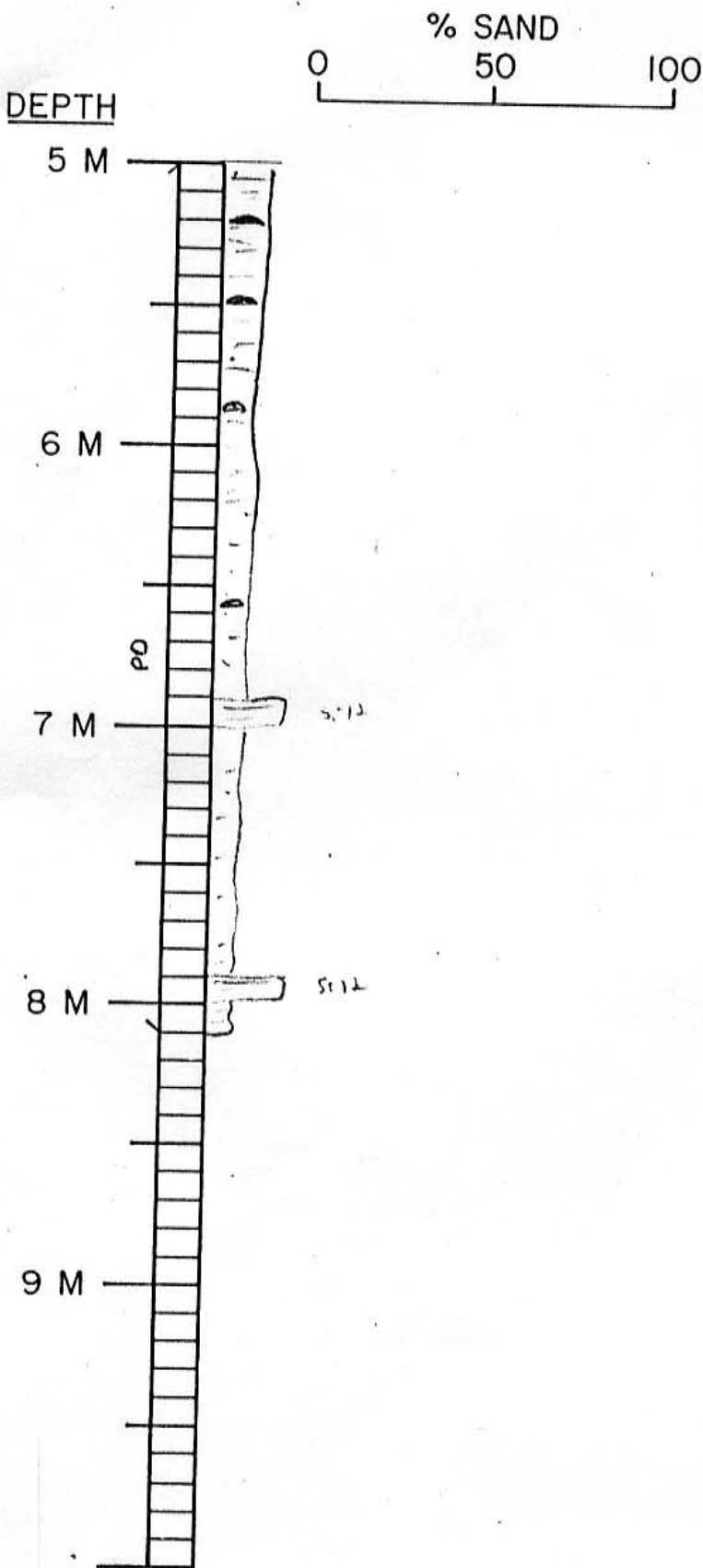
Fine-grained, well-sorted sand - 25% rounded shell - massive - bracketed caline sharp contact

UPPER FINE-GRAINED UNIT

Dr gray silty clay interbedded with sand stringer between - 3.8 & - 4.3m. This sequence corresponds - below the sand stringers change to silt stringers - (light gray). Some circular burrow near top (?) - horizontal to sub horizontal bedding
